8 WEEKS

- 6 in 1 (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Whooping cough, Polio, Hib, Hepatitis B)
- Rotavirus
- MenB



12 WEEKS

- 6 in 1 (2nd Dose)
- Rotavirus (2nd Dose)
- MenB (2nd Dose)



16 WEEKS

- 6 in 1 (3rd Dose)
- Pneumococcal



1 YEAR

- MMR
- Pneumococcal
- MenB
- Hib/MenC (for children born on or before 30th June 2024)



18 MONTHS

- 6 in 1 (4th Dose for children born on or after 1st July 2024)
- MMR



3 YEARS & 4 MONTHS

- MMR (2nd Dose for children born on or before 30th June 2024)
- 4 in 1 Pre School Booster
